5. HARBORMASTER REPORT

Harbormaster David Schlaefer is still finding unregistered and non-paid moorings. He asked the Harbor Committee to send out a letter requesting every mooring be numbered. All moorings need to be pulled out during the dredging and un-numbered, un-registered mooring will not be replaced. Harbormaster David Schlaefer would like the same said for Seal Cove.

Harbormaster David Schlaefer has had new pins made for the finger floats and will be setting those floats soon.

Harbormaster David Schlaefer feels that the Harbor Ordinance should be changed to dictate the size of the punts that can be tied up at the Wharf. There are many punts that are too large for the cramped space available for them. If, after the dredging is finished, more floats are added, he thinks maybe designating an area just for the larger punts might solve the problem.
