1. CALL TO ORDER

The November 24, 2009 Tremont Harbor Committee meeting was called to order at 5:00pm, by Chairman Jon Crossman.

2. ROLL CALL

Present were Harbor Committee members Jon Crossman, Art Paine, Mike Ryan, Mel Atherton, Dean Wass, Mark Mosenteen, Town Manager Millard Billings, Harbor Master David Schalefer, and Recording Secretary McKenzie Jewett. Member so the public included, Morgan Black, Travis Murphy, Michail Jewett, and Chris Eaton. Absent Spencer Ervin.

3. TOWN MANAGERS REPORT

Town Manger Billings informed the Harbor Committee that he has received emails from Mike Tuttle and Mark Habel concerning the dredging of Bass Harbor. The ocean survey has been completed and nothing obvious was found. Still waiting for "official" results of the survey.

Invoices were mailed to three residents to for float disposal. Town Manager Billings wanted clarification on how to proceed with un-paid invoices. Chairman Jon Crossman felt the amount that was charged was excessive but needed to be paid regardless. It was decided that the Town would send a second notice to residents.

MOTION by Harbor Committee member Mark Mosenteen to send second notice stating that invoice is past due. After December 25, 2009, send a third notice more strong notice., seconded by Harbor Committee member Mike Ryan. All in favor 5-1, Chairman Crossman abstained.

4. HARBOR MASTER REPORT

Morgan Black and Travis Murphy were present to discuss wharf permits. Both fisherman hold wharf permits as of now and are 2 years behind. Mr. Black stated that he felt it was unreasonable to expect that fisherman to have to pay 2 years worth of wharf permits. Chairman Crossman explained that Mr. Black has used the wharf for the past 2 years, and it is his responsibility to pay the fees that are required of him. Mr. Black felt that the Harbor Master was singling out a small group of fisherman. Harbor Master Schlaefer explained that he and the office staff were compiling a list of all delinquent wharf permits; the entire list was not ready for this meeting. After much discussion Chairman Crossman informed both

Mr. Black and Mr. Murphy that they were required to pay permits, or there permits may be suspended.

Next Harbor Committee meeting will be December 9, 2009.
