**1. CALL TO ORDER**

The July 29, 2010 Tremont Harbor Committee meeting was called to order at 5:00PM by Chairman Jon Crossman.

**(Roll call was left off agenda)-** Present were Chairman Jon Crossman, Harbor Committee Members Wayne Rich, Mel Atherton, Dean Wass, Spencer Ervin, Town Manger Millard Billings, Recording Secretary McKenzie Jewett, Harbor Master David Schlaefer. Members of the public included Todd Prock, Stephen Durell-Prock Marine, Chris Eaton, Charlie Dillon, Danny Closson and Josh Chalmers

**2. ACCEPT MINUTES**

**MOTION** by Harbor Committee Member Mel Atherton to approve the minutes of June 24, 2010, seconded by Harbor Committee Member Spencer Ervin. 3-2, Dean was absent from meeting; Wayne Rich is a new member and was not at the June 24, 2010 meeting.

**Meeting was moved out of order 5A-PROCK MARINE DREDGE PROJECT/WHARF GARAGE RENTAL**

Stephen Durrell and Todd Prock were present to answer any questions the Harbor Committee had concerning dredging. They presented the board with a tentative schedule (see attached letter) beginning September 29 Prock will begin breaking up ledge with a hole-ram, removal won't happen until November 1, 2010. Removal of moorings will go out for bid. Notices will be posted and run in local papers informing mooring holders that there moorings must be in good condition, any broken chains, staples etc will be the responsibility of the mooring holder not the Town. Moorings that are removed cannot be put back without the approval of the Army Corp. Harbor Master David Schlaefer will do his best to accommodate those who fish year round.

The Harbor Committee received a request from D and R Bait to rent the wharf garage for \$800.00 per month D and R would be using the garage to store bait.

**MOTION** by Harbor Committee Member Mel Atherton to recommend to the Tremont Board of Selectmen to enter into a lease agreement with D and R Bait for one year, with the understanding that all bait must be prepared in fish trays, bait must enter the wharf and leave the wharf in the same manner and no waste will be dumped in the Harbor, seconded by Chairman Jon Crossman. 5-0 all in favor.

**3. TOWN MANAGER REPORT**

There was much discussion concerning the specifications for mooring removal bids. It was decided that the bids should be per lift not per mooring. Many moorings may have to be moved more than once. Any maintenance needed for the moorings (i.e. new staples, chains etc.) will be left between the mooring holder and the contractor. Bids must be awarded by September 14, 2010, in case there is a need for an article at Special Town Meeting.
